He presently serves as an Emeritus Trustee for the College of Southern Nevada Foundation, on the Board of the Clark County Public Education Foundation and the Desert Research Institute Foundation. He is a past President of the American Institute of Architects for both the Las Vegas and Nevada chapters, and is a former Chairman of the Board of Opportunity Village. Schoeman's achievements have won him the American Institute of Architects' Nevada Silver Medal and the Desert Research Institute's President's Medal. JMA is the recipient of numerous industry awards including the American Institute of Architects Western Mountain Region Firm of the Year Award. Thomas Schoeman was the architect for the original part of CSN's Ralph & Betty Engelstad School of Health Sciences Building and the City of Las Vegas Fire Station 6/CSN Instructional Center at the College's Charleston Campus.
