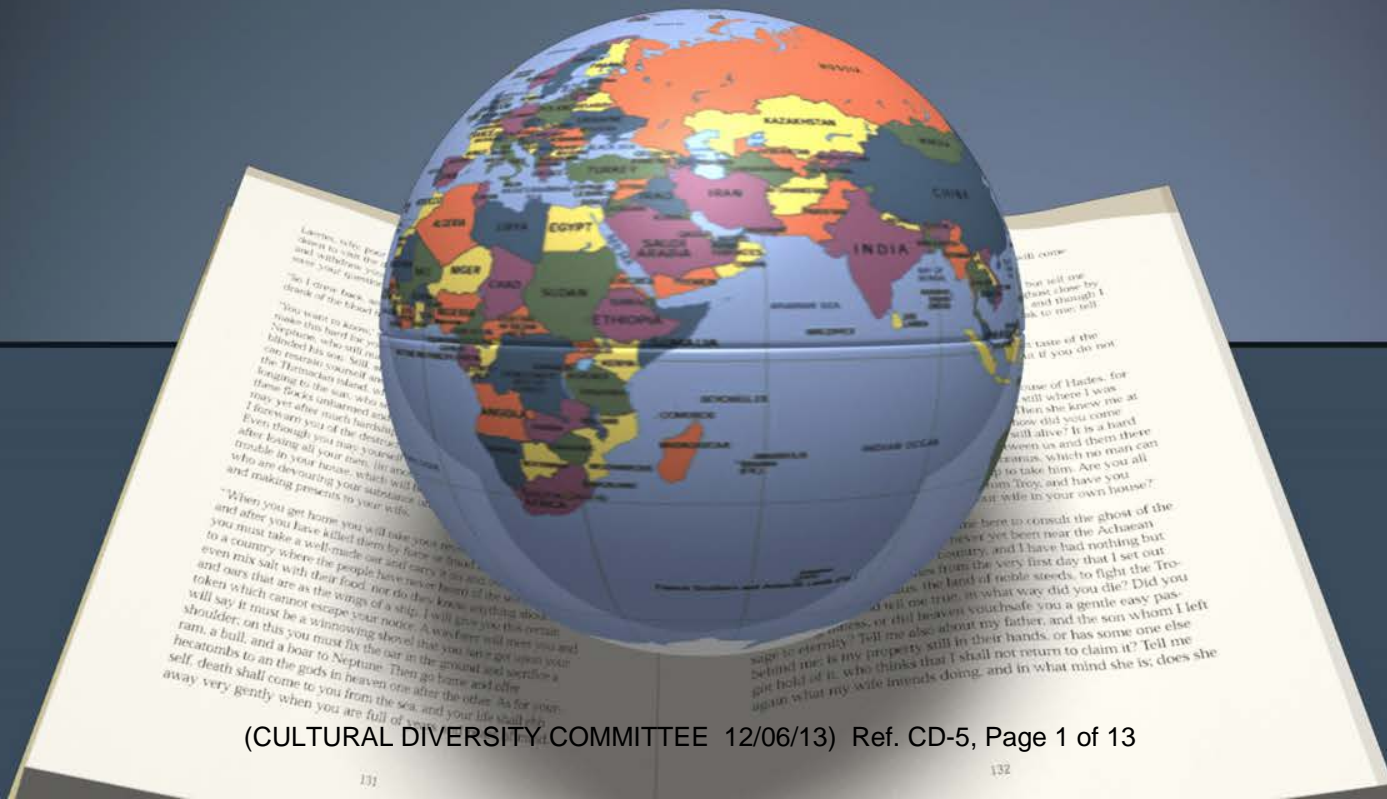


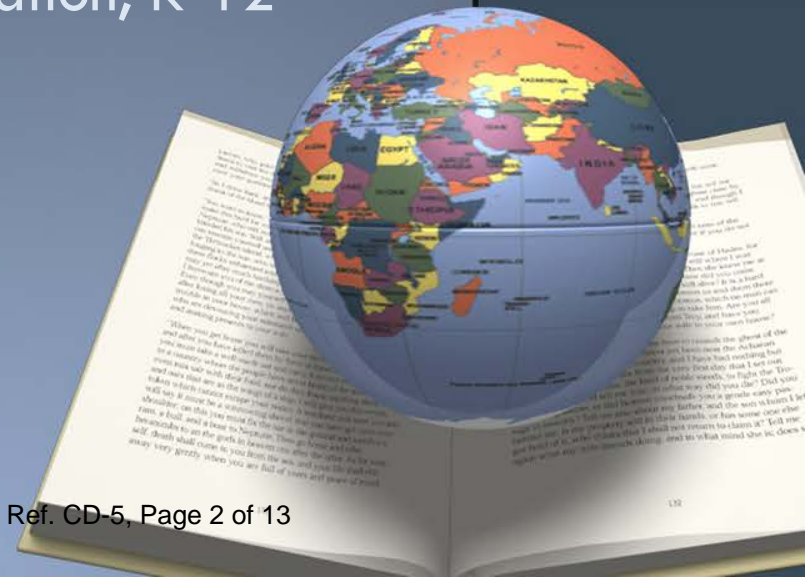


# 2013 NSHE Northern Nevada Diversity Summit

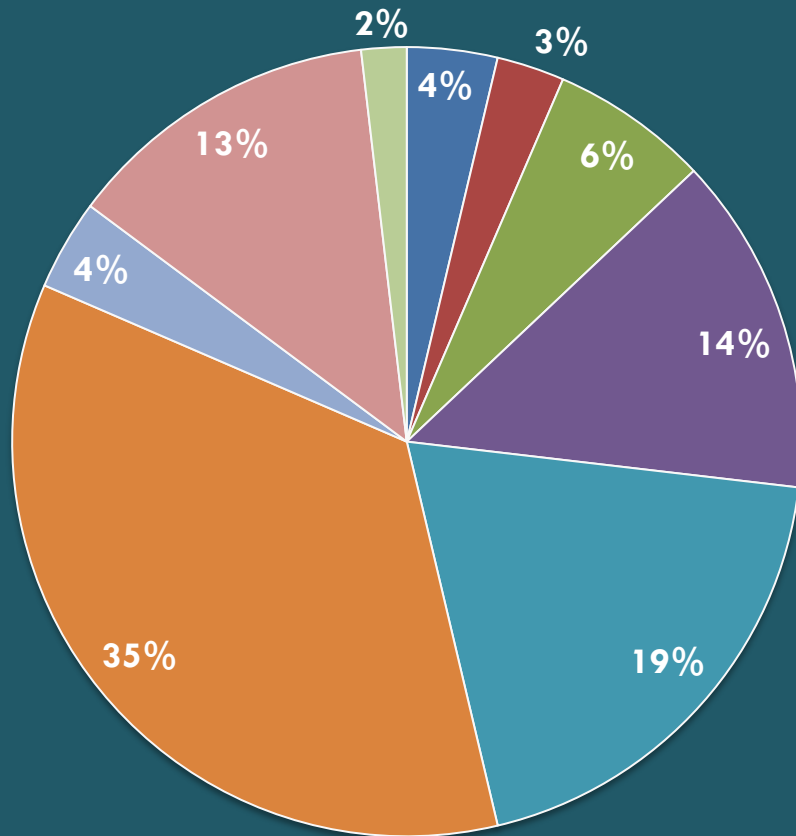


# Attendance

# Summit Evaluations

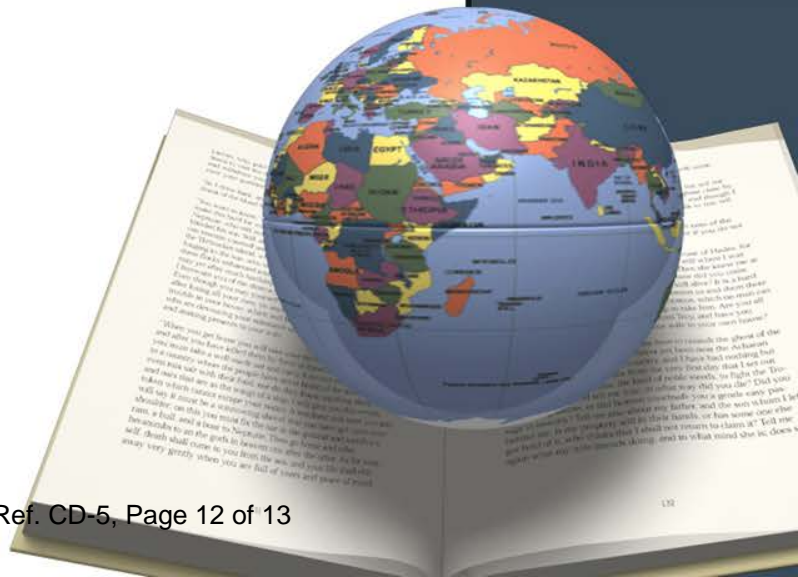
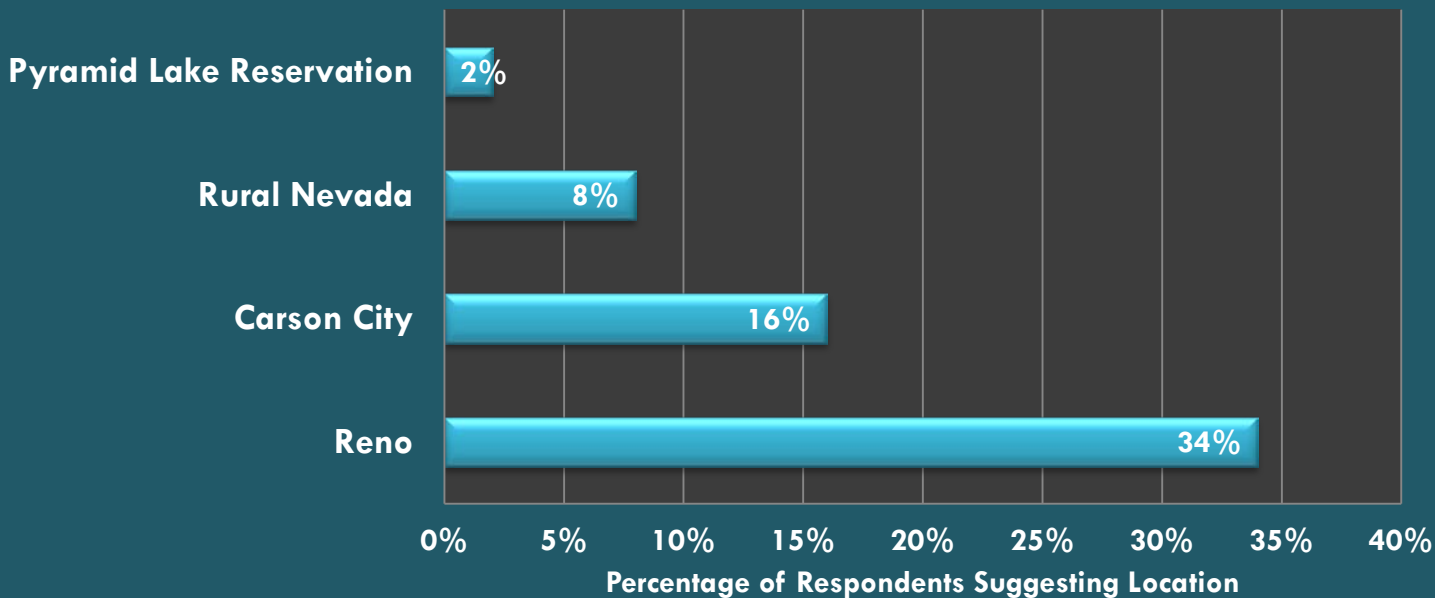
- 46% response rate for the Summit evaluations.
