#### 2. BACKGROUND & POLICY CONTEXT OF ISSUE:

The Board of Regents approved at its December 2014 meeting the changing of the name from the High Tech Center at Redfield to the Health Science Center at Redfield. In September 2014, the William N. Pennington Foundation contributed \$2M to the construction of the Health Science Center building on the Redfield campus. The grant agreement stated that the grantor reserves the naming opportunity of the building with determination of naming to be made on or before May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015 at Grantor's discretion. On April 14, 2015, TMCC was notified that the Foundation will be naming the building the William N. Pennington Health Science Center.

## 3. SPECIFIC ACTIONS BEING RECOMMENDED OR REQUESTED:

President Maria Sheehan requests approval to name the current Health Science Center at Redfield the William N. Pennington Health Science Center. The William N. Pennington Foundation donated \$2M toward the building project, which came with the naming opportunity.

#### 4. IMPETUS (WHY NOW?):

At its April 2015 Board meeting, the William N. Pennington Foundation elected to name the Health Science Center after the Foundation, which was offered in TMCC's request for \$2M in support for the building.

## 5. BULLET POINTS TO SUPPORT REQUEST/RECOMMENDATION:

- In the proposal to the William N. Pennington Foundation, TMCC provided the opportunity to name the building after the Foundation with a gift of \$2M.
- Naming the building after William N. Pennington will add prestige to TMCC, the Health Science Center and the Redfield campus
