Agenda Item Title: Tutoring Effectiveness on Student Success Meeting Date: June 11-12, 2015 2. BACKGROUND & POLICY CONTEXT OF ISSUE: TMCC's Tutoring and Learning Center (TLC) exists to support the institution in its mission to improve the quality of life for its students. The TLC provides free tutoring to TMCC students in several subject areas and writing across all disciplines. Students get three free hours of one-on-one appointments each week and an unlimited time in our drop-in labs, and they can participate in supplemental instruction groups as well as attend workshops on student success. Research shows that students who use tutoring complete courses at a higher rate, persist at a higher rate, and earn higher grades than those who do not use tutoring. 3. SPECIFIC ACTIONS BEING RECOMMENDED OR REQUESTED: Informational item only. 4. IMPETUS (WHY NOW?): With much of TMCC's funding tied directly to completion, this presentation will demonstrate how students who use tutoring are more successful than and complete classes at higher rates than their peers who do not use tutoring. 5. Services to Support Students

Overview



The Tutoring and Learning Center (TLC) at Truckee Meadows Community College provides free tutoring to TMCC students in many subject areas, including Biology, Chemistry, Economics, French, Math, Physics, Spanish, Writing, and more. We provide one-on-one tutoring, drop-in tutoring, and supplemental instruction. Students can also attend workshops in on a variety of helpful topics, use computers with Internet access, print papers for free, and rent graphing calculators.

Our Mission

TMCC's Tutoring and Learning Center exists to support the institution in its mission to improve the quality of life for its students. In this effort, the TLC staffs its inviting environment with well-trained tutors to help students become independent learners for academic success. Tutors are trained to create a positive learning experience, to clarify content, and to help students to attain higher academic achievement.

Services We Provide

One-on-One Appointments (2007 – present)

Students can get up to three hours of one-on-one help for nearly any class in which they are enrolled. There are course-specific tutors to clarify content as well as writing tutors to help with all phases of the writing process.

Drop-in Tutoring (2007 – present)

Students can drop in for help for an unlimited amount of time during the semester. There are tutors available to help with most levels of math and science as well as writing. The drop-in area is a great place to get one or two questions answered or to get homework done.

Supplemental Instruction (2007 – present)

Students enrolled in traditionally demanding or difficult courses can attend weekly group tutoring sessions that supplement the instructor's material. Tutors are former students who work with faculty to create regularly-scheduled, informal sessions in which students compare notes and study for tests.

Online and eTutoring (2015 – present)


Students can work with TMCC writing tutors online in two modalities: synchronously or asynchronously. In online appointments, both the student and tutor communicate in real-time while an eTutoring appointment will have the student will submit a paper to be reviewed.

Workshops (2007 - present)


Students have been able to attend free workshops ranging from time management and stress reduction (2008 – 2010) to graphing calculator, essay formatting, and test anxiety (2010 – 2012), from computer skills and creating a math mind (2012 – 2013) to note taking and writing basics (2013 – present).

Students who use the TLC are **retained at a higher rate** at TMCC. Students who use the TLC **persist at TMCC at higher rate**. Students who use the TLC **averaged above a 3.0 GPA** in their classes for which they received tutoring, while students who did not use tutoring in those same classes averaged around a 2.76 GPA.



One-on-One Appointments

- Students get up to three hours of free tutoring per week in subject (content) and/or writing tutoring.
- Appointments can be either 30-minute or hour-long, depending on the student's preference.

Supplemental Instruction

The SI program consists of a series of guided review sessions for students taking particular courses



What is SI?

Weekly study sessions are facilitated by SI Leaders during which students participate in a variety of activities, including:

- short lectures on challenging material
- group work
- practice problems
- exam review
- and more

Implementing SI

- Surveys are administered in class during first week of the semester to determine the optimal times to offer SI
- SI begins the second week of the semester
- SI Leaders attend class and meet with instructors as needed.

What Students Get out of SI

- Further review of important concepts from class
- The opportunity to work on practice problems/material under the guidance of an SI leader
- A comfortable place to compare notes and get to know other students who are tackling the same material
 - Additional review before exams

Benefits of Attending SI

- Students who use SI average one half to one full letter grade higher than classmates who do not attend SI sessions
 - Students are able to transfer study skills learned in SI to other classes lacking SI support.

Note: At TMCC, the success of SI is highly dependent on how supportive instructors are of the SI sessions, and how often students attend SI.


Like all of the other services offered by the TLC, Supplemental Instruction is free to TMCC students!*

Drop-In Tutoring

Drop-in tutoring is available six days a week at the TLC



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Drop-in Tutoring Usage

Drop-in tutoring accounts for approximately 25% of all tutoring*.

*Based on several years worth of math tutoring data. Science and writing drop-in tutoring is still relatively new (2013) but we expect to see this trend continue.

Comparison of one-one-one appointments and math drop-in usage








**Data compares retention rates, persistence rates, and GPA of students who used tutoring to students that did not use tutoring for the same courses.

Retention* - TLC Students vs All TMCC Students







Retention - All TMCC Students

*Persistence is the percent of students who enroll in TMCC the following semester.

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Average GPA

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NOTE: Students who use tutoring three or more times in a semester earned a significantly higher GPA compared to those students who used tutoring two times or fewer.

- Students who use the TLC are retained at a higher rate, persist at a higher rate, and earn higher grades on average.
 - It is not just by chance that students do better in their classes when they receive more tutoring!
 - The TLC is able to serve many students effectively for much less that the market cost of individual tutoring.

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If you see students who are in need of CPR (completion, persistence, and retention), a little TLC may be all they need...
