

Annual Tuition and Median Household Income




Ratio of Institutional Support vs. instructional spending



Building Utilization




Salaries of top Administrators

National Survey of Student Engagement

- ▶ 85% of First-year and 95% of seniors rated their entire educational experience at this institution as 'excellent' or 'good.'
- Freshmen and Seniors rate NSC high in the following indicators. These responses surpass the averages for the Far West Public institutions, NSC's Carnegie Class and the entire NSSE 2013 survey.
 - Effective teaching practices (76%)

 - Quality of interactions (67%)



- ► 69% First generation students


First-time, Full-time 1-yr, fall to fall Retention Rates



First-time, Full-time Graduation Rates within Institution as of Summer


