

Background on Student Union Proposal Development



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<u>Student Leadership</u>: home and consistent location for Associated Students of College of Southern Nevada (ASCSN), on each of the 3 campuses.



<u>Sense of Belonging</u>: a natural gathering place for students on campus, enables a sense of belonging, community and engagement. Students have a sense of connectedness to the campus, whether full-time or part-time. <u>Collaboration</u>: provides an environment for intellectual and cultural exchange, and peer discussion.

Food Service, Meeting, and Event: provides food service and flexible space to accommodate small and large student and campus event gatherings, as well as meeting space for student clubs. Learning and Work Space: students will have spaces to come together to work on class activities, service projects, engage with student leaders, and display their accomplishments (art, science, research projects, etc.).

<u>Center Point for Campus</u>: the Student Unions will serve as the central point of campus and attract students, families, campus faculty and staff, and community to the CSN campus.

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


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West Charleston Site Plan






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Henderson Site Plan




