Western Undergraduate Exchange Program (WUE)

- Nevada residents may enroll in many 2-year or 4-year public colleges in 14 western states and pay a reduced tuition rate.
- Most undergraduate fields are available.
- WUE students pay the same rate as in-state residents plus 50% of the in-state resident rate.
 - * For example, if the in-state resident rate is \$10,000 per year, then WUE students pay \$15,000 per year.
- The tuition rate for WUE students is significantly less than the tuition rate for nonresident students.

(WRGP)

Professional Student Exchange Program (PSEP)

- Through PSEP, WICHE will help Nevada residents pay for their education in:
 - **⇒** Optometry
 - ⇒ Pharmacy
 - **⇒ Veterinary Medicine**
- PSEP students must return to Nevada and practice in the profession they are trained in for a set period of time.
- 75% of the financial aid provided by WICHE will not need to be repaid if the service agreement is fulfilled.
- Students must pay back 25% of the WICHE financial aid within 5-10 years after completing their education.

Health Care Access Program (HCAP)

- Through HCAP, WICHE will help Nevada residents pay for their education in:
 - \Rightarrow Nursing
 - ⇒ Pharmacy
 - ⇒ Physical Therapy
 - ⇒ Physician Assistant
- When HCAP students finish their education, they must complete the following service agreement:
 - ⇒ Work in Nevada
 - ⇒ Work with a medically underserved population or in a medically underserved region.
 - \Rightarrow For 2 years
- ◆ 100% of the WICHE financial aid will be forgiven if the service agreement is successfully completed.

Health Care Access Program (HCAP) -Loan Repayment

- After students have completed their education, WICHE may assist them in paying back school loans.
- Eligible career fields for loan repayment:
 - \Rightarrow **Dentistry**
 - * You must work in Nevada with a medically underserved population for 2 years.
 - ⇒ Mental Health
 - * You must work in a staterun facility for 2 years
 - \Rightarrow Nursing
 - * You must work at the University Medical Center in Las Vegas
- Students will not have to repay WICHE funds if they successfully complete the service agreement.
